Andrew Buxton joined DBS as director on 17 February 2006.

A career banker, he capped an illustrious 36-year career at Barclays Bank Plc with his appointment as Chairman in 1993, a position he held until his retirement in 1999. Following his retirement, he served as senior advisor to the Barclays Group on its Middle East business until 2003.

He was President of the British Bankers Association from 1998 to 2002 and a Director of the Bank of England from 1997 to 2001. He has also been Chairman of the Charing Cross and Westminster Medical School in London, the Department of Trade and Industry Overseas Projects Board, the European Services Forum, and the Saudi British Joint Business Council.

He is now a financial consultant and serves on a number of company boards, including Xansa plc and Allied Schools Ltd. He is also Patron of the National Education Business Partnership Network which promotes links between business and education.

For his services to international trade, Buxton was made a Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George in the Queen's Birthday Honours in June 2003.

Buxton, a British citizen, holds a Masters degree in Politics, Philosophy and Economics from Oxford University. He was also awarded an honorary Doctor of Science from City University, London, and is a Fellow of the Institute of Bankers, UK.
