
What You Need to Know About Investing in REITs

What are REITs?

REITs or **Real Estate Investment Trusts** are **investments in a portfolio of income-generating real estate assets.** The revenue comes mainly from the rental income of the properties, which is then distributed to investors periodically in cash.



6 common categories of REITs




Hospitality REITs - Hotels & Resorts

Advantages of investing in REITs





REITs typically own multiple property portfolios with diverse senants – reducing the risk of relying on a single property and senant, as with owning a property directly.



As REITs are listed on the exchange, you can buy and sell shares easily, and in smaller amounts as compared to buying or selling a physical property.


Did You Know?

S-REITs (Singapore-listed REITs) which comprise both Singapore and Overseas real estate assets also offer investors the greatest international exposure in terms of geographical spread.

The property assets of the S-REITs sector as a whole span as many as 20 other countries outside of Singapore!
